OPPORTUNITY HIGHLIGHTS:

Battle Creek Health System has an excellent opportunity for a Med/Peds physician to join an existing group. This thriving, five-physician private primary care group seeks a new doctor to meet the needs of an expanding, diverse, patient population in Battle Creek, Michigan. The practice is clinic based and does no OB. Call consists of after-hours telephone consultation and routine newborn hospital care. Hospitalists provide adult inpatient care. Call is typically 1 in 5 and options for not taking call are negotiable. Call is taken one week at a time and is generally light. The practice is open seven days a week and scheduling is flexible. Weekend office hours are four hours per month. Opportunities to teach physician assistant and nurse practitioner students are available. Special interests in medicine will likely be accommodated and encouraged.

The office is located in the Medical Office Building adjoining the hospital and ambulatory care center, and is well equipped to perform standard procedures including colposcopy, vasectomy, joint injections and dermatologic therapies. The office has fully integrated EMR. Office staff includes six mid-level providers. Patient volume averages 900 per week and is increasing. Patient population is 35% BCBS, 9 % Medicare, 7% Medicaid, and the remainder privately insured and self pay. The office cares for patients of all ages. The practice has been designated by BCBS as a patient centered medical home and ranked in the top ten percent of BCBS practices in Michigan. The practice has a 31-year history and is financially successful. The practice is focused on patient satisfaction.

This opportunity offers an Initial base salary of \$160,000-\$175,000 depending on specialty, training and experience. Highly productive physicians will receive a productivity bonus. Malpractice insurance, full benefits, 401K and vacation/CME are provided. Relocation expenses will be paid.
