South Bend, Indiana – located 80 miles east of Chicago, the South Bend/Mishawaka region is the commercial and industrial metropolitan center of North-Central Indiana with a population of more than 240,000. There are 20 lakes to choose from as well as the Yellow and Tippecanoe Rivers. Lake Maxinkuckee, the second largest spring-fed lake in Indiana, also offers plenty of sailing and water-skiing. The state-managed Menominee Wildlife Conservation Area also offers other recreational sports such as hiking and bird watching. The scenic bicycle ride from Plymouth to Culver and Lake Maxinkuckee and to Ancilla College and Gilbert Lake is a popular spring, summer and fall attraction.
